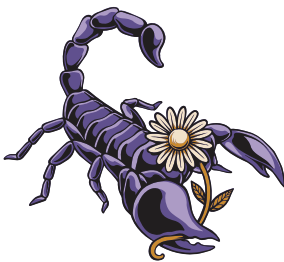

ICMELER THERMAL SPRING

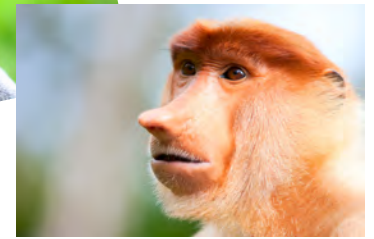
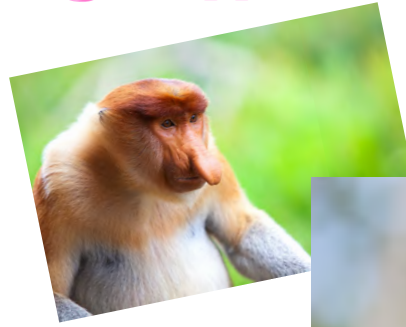

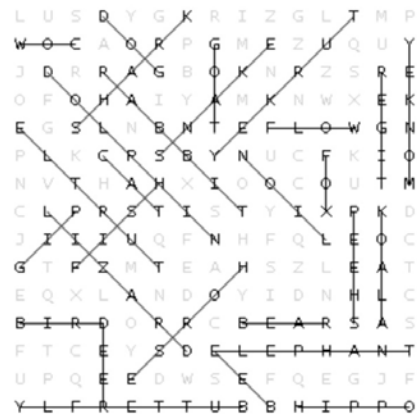
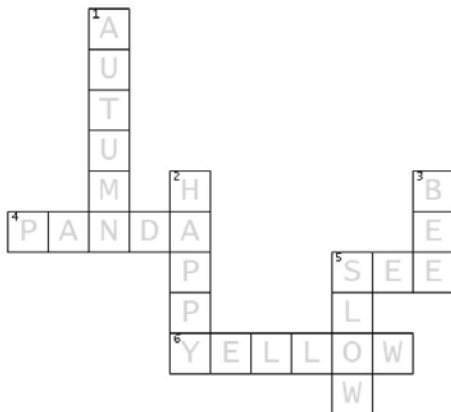
1. Slicing fruits quickly can make your reflexes better.
